Kingston School of Art is one of the best art and design schools in the world and ranked among Europe's top 50 architecture schools. Based on Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA) curriculum.

- First Year focused on the acquisition and consolidation of architectural representation and drawing skills.
- The Design Studio works featured site-based projects, addressing the principles and context of architectural design. It also included and real scale-built project.
- The coursework supporting studies comprised assignments on drawing, model-making, materials, sustainability, professional practice and the history of architecture.
- Second Year Projects included Tectonic Projects
 - Semester I: An Art Room for Old Palace Primary School;
 - Semester II: An Alternative School Addition for Bromley Hall School.
- The second-year project was focused on educational spaces for children at primary school level. The brief was to support creative and art practices; connect the divide between the inner life of the sites and their surrounding communities; and to support progressive teaching practices, focusing on child-lead, personalized, and democratic learning.
- Third Year Projects included the Studio Project and Dissertation Project.
 - The Rough and the Smooth – to create a new archive for the Fashion department at the University of Westminster. The studio research and design work is a basis for investigation on the spatial possibilities of the fashion research centre and turn into the ideas for future archive centre.
 - BA Dissertation: The Royal Pavilion Brighton | the picturesque concept – the integration of architecture and landscape – this
 - Dissertation Project could also be transferred into the Year 3's design studio project "The Rough and the Smooth" – How to deal with old structure, whether to maintaining, covering or demolishing. The decision of materials and decoration are also essential aspects. More importantly, the new transformation should perform effectively according to its new purpose.
