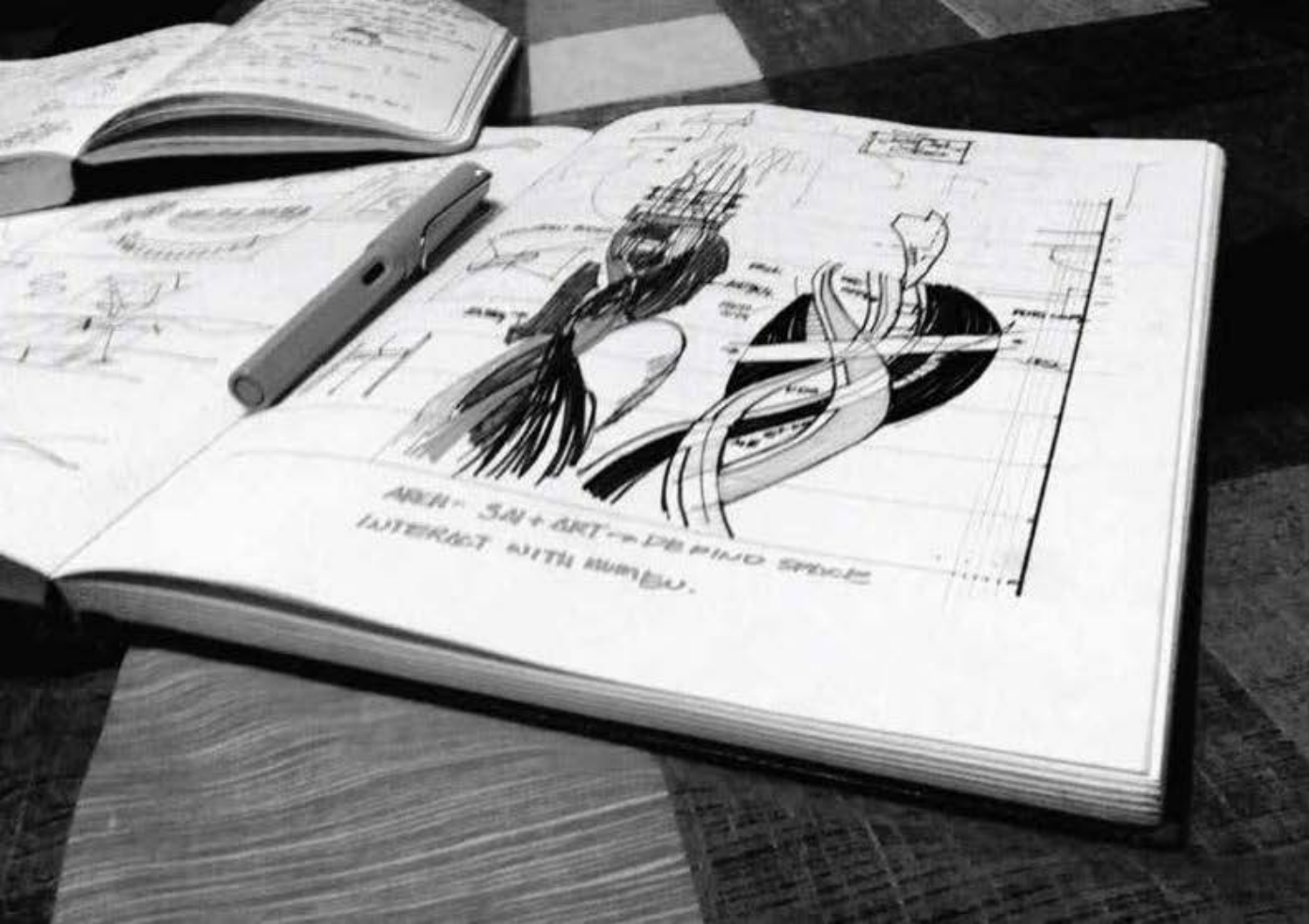

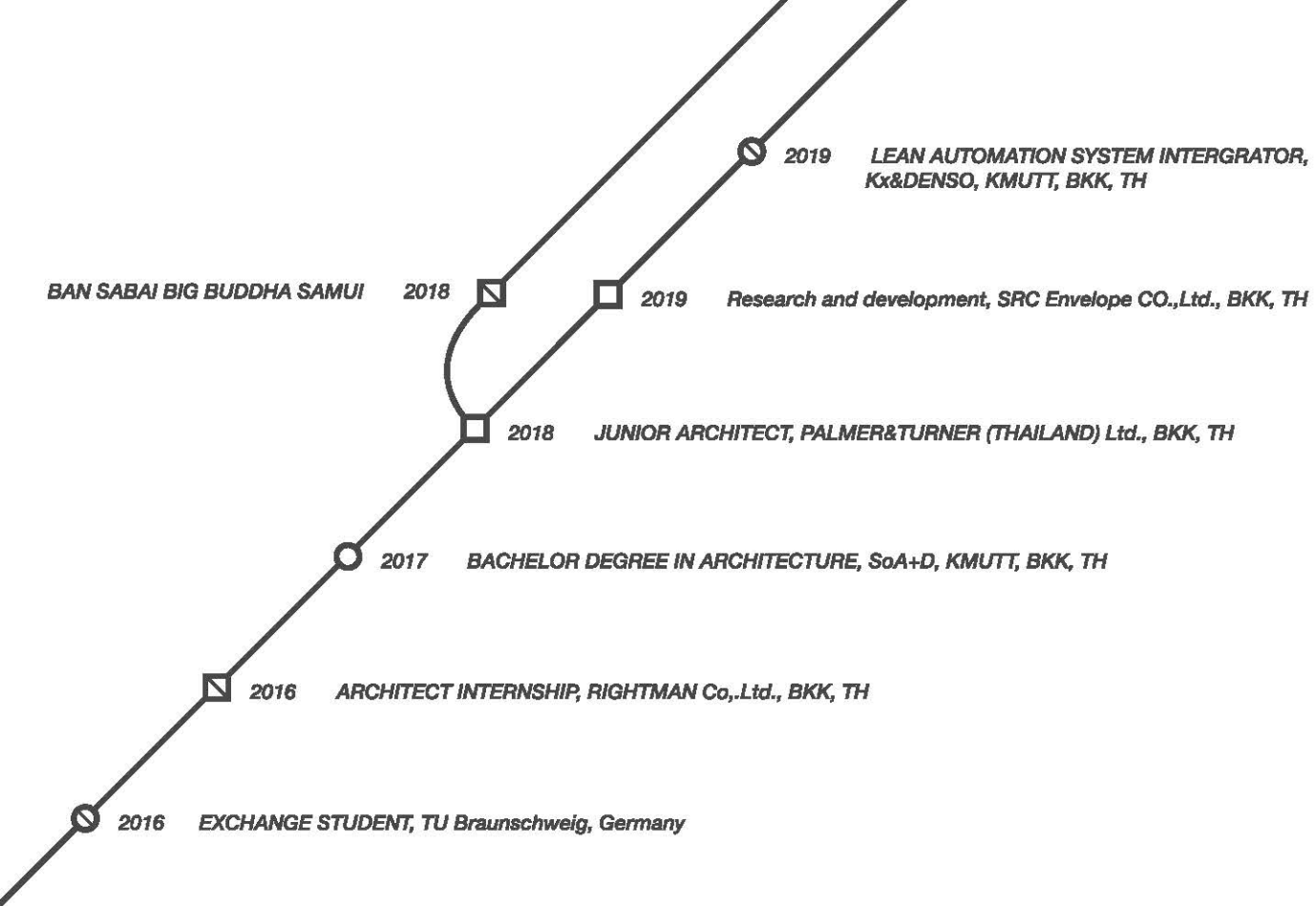

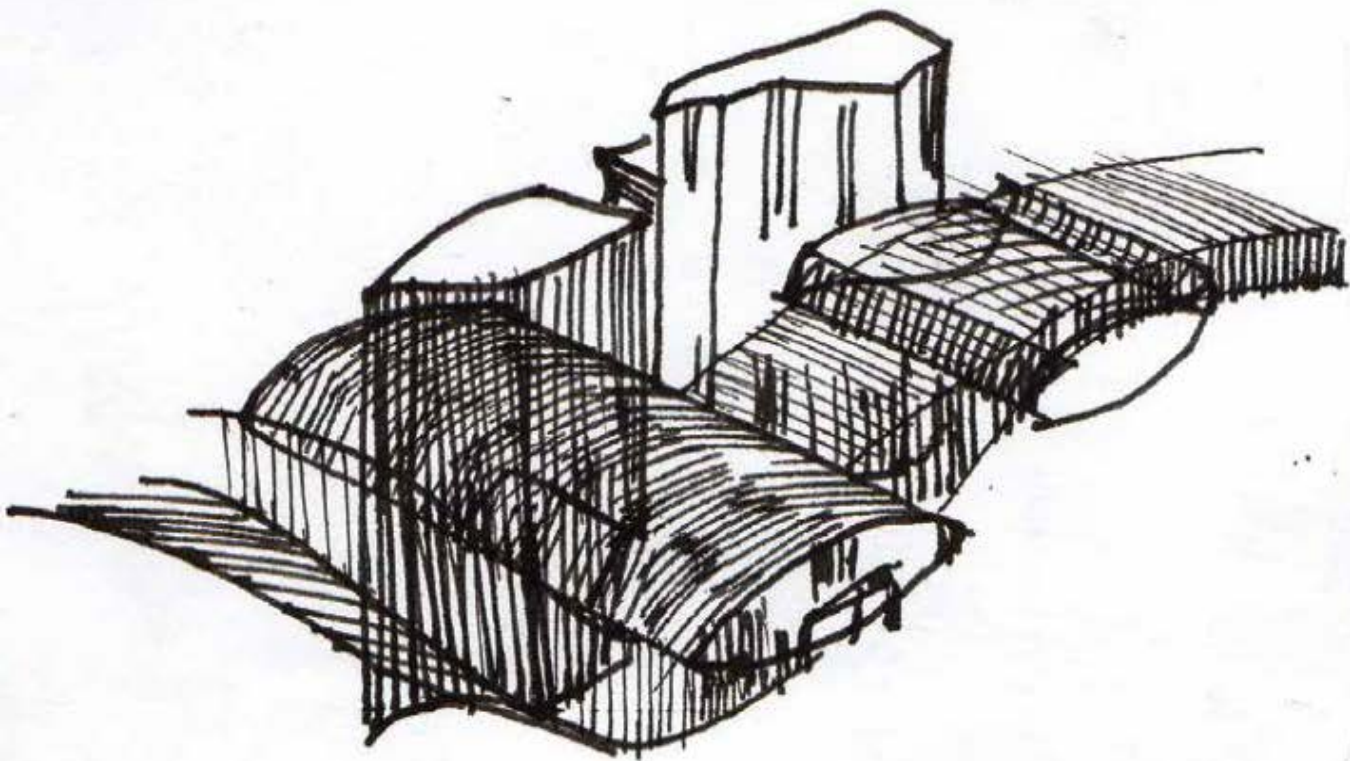
Thai Pavillion

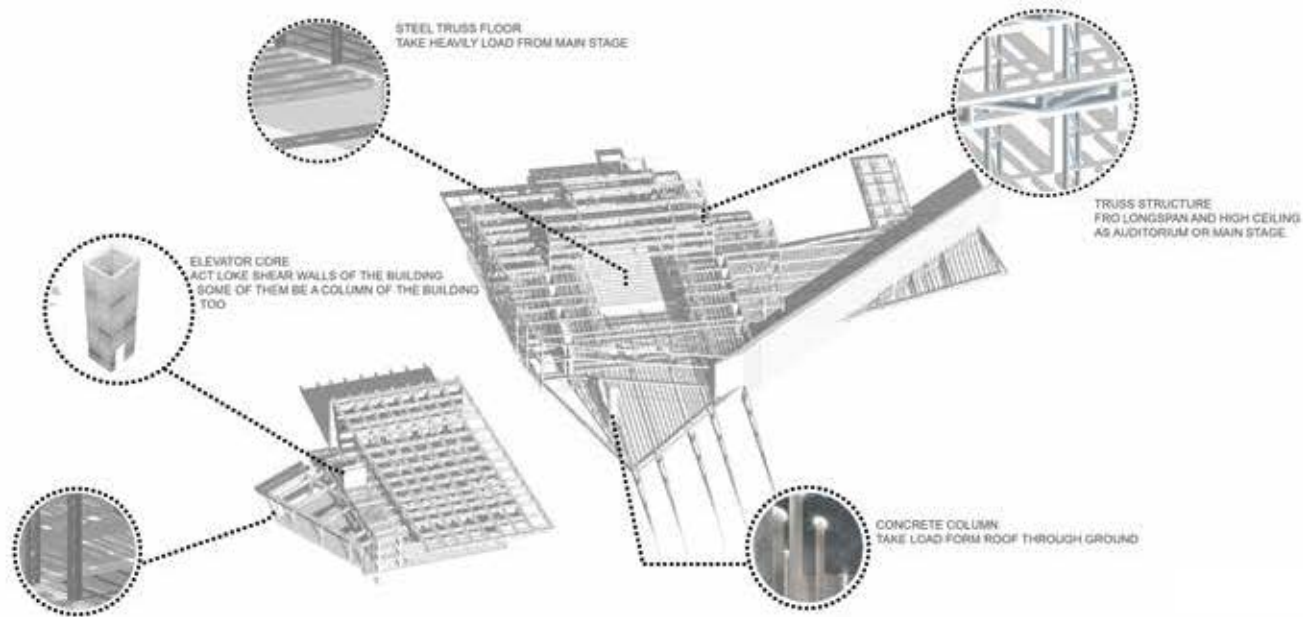

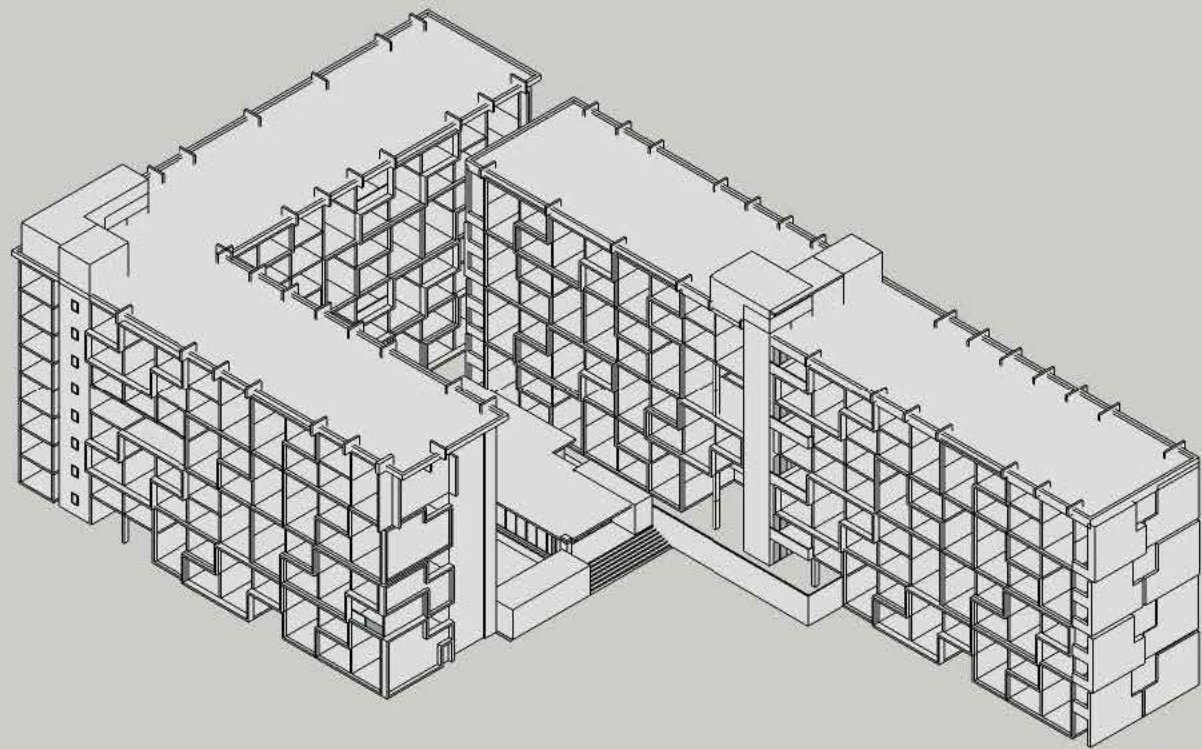

concept: Matrix

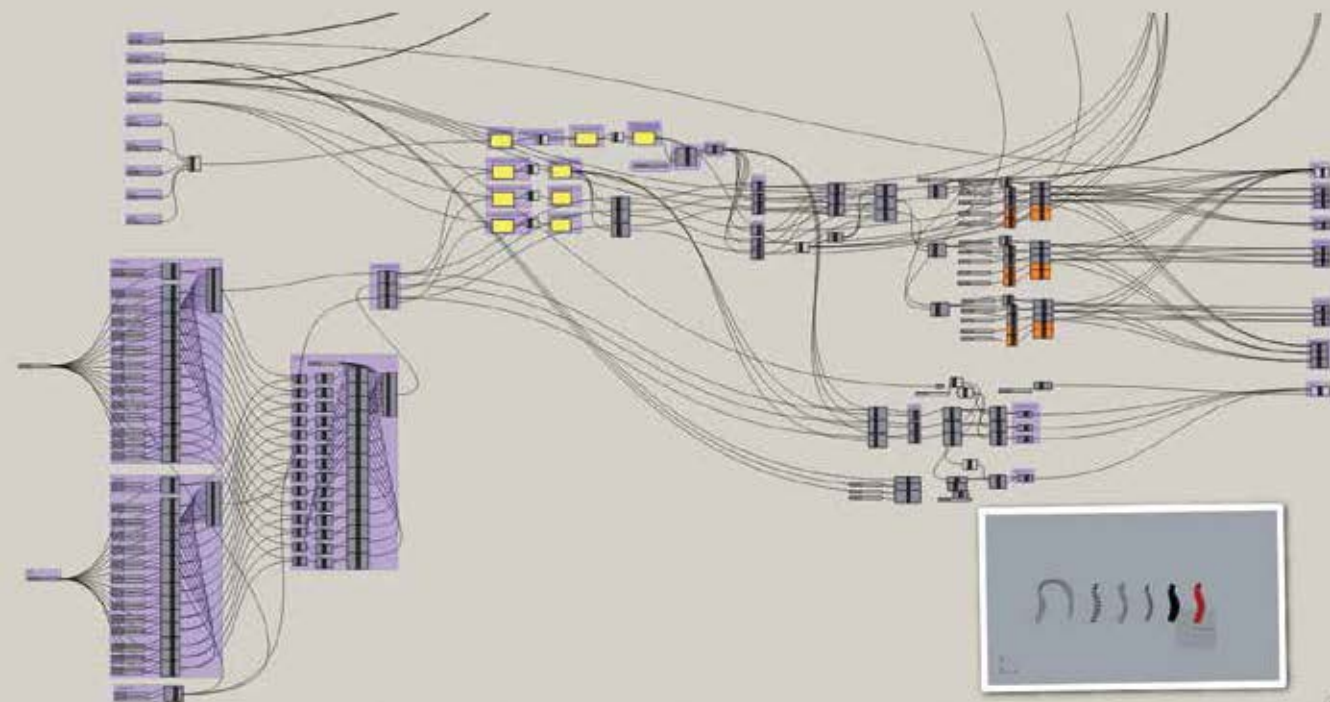

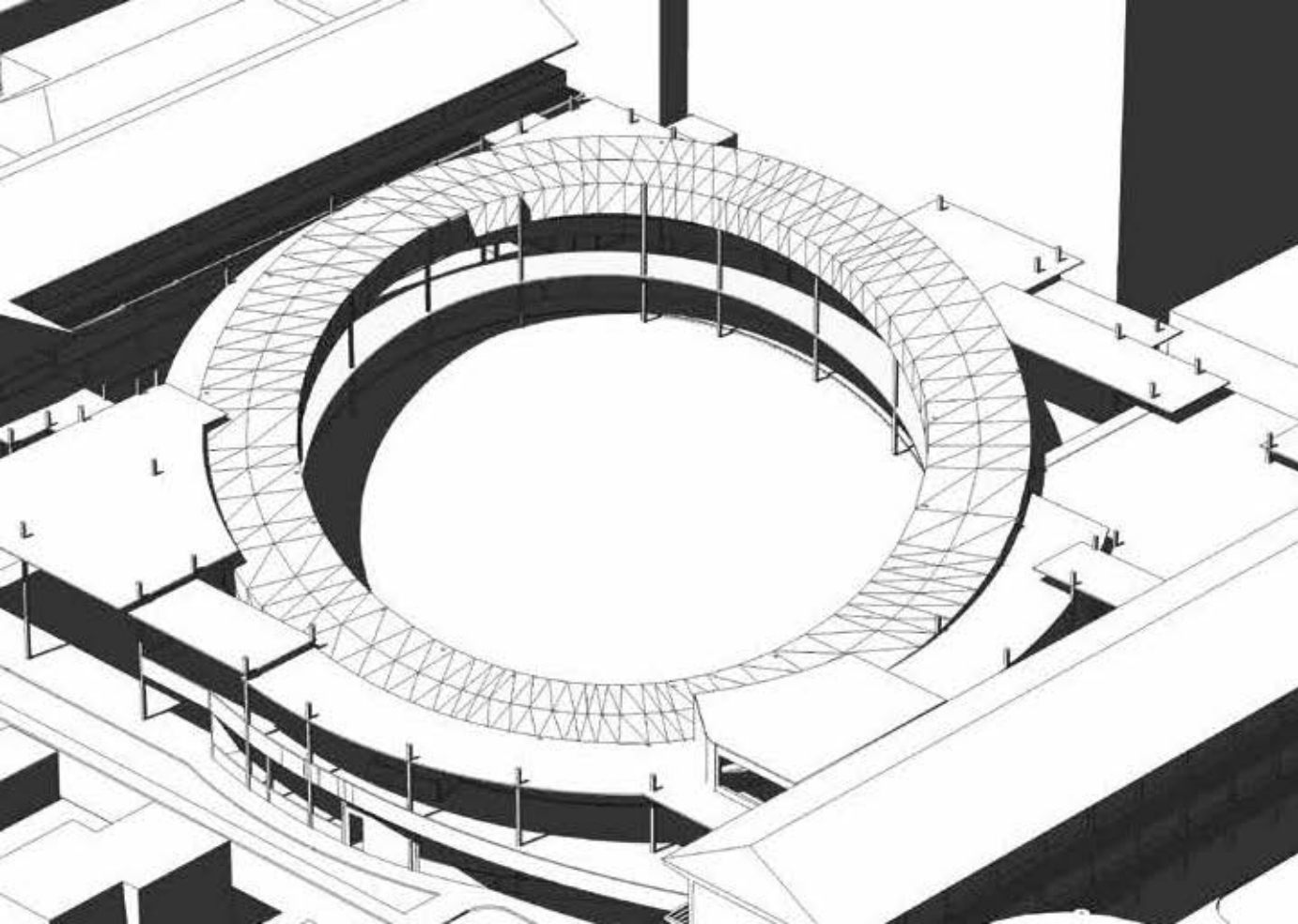
Urban farming knowledge center

First of all, I study traditional farming in the countryside to apply to urban farming but I found that traditional farm method is growing only one type of vegetable. And this method has pro and con. The good thing about this method is it needs low knowledge and it easy to take care. For the bad thing, it has 3 majors as used many manpower, resource, and insect pests.

First, manpower. Doing traditional farming is having very poor quality of manpower because in one year can growing only 1-2 rounds. Therefore the farm will have to work very hard on the time that growing plant and harvest plant.

Second, the traditional farming method is linear productivity line. Farmer has to investment from the beginning then add on some support material as fertilizer to make plant tree growing fast. In the end harvest, the products then repeat the loop again.

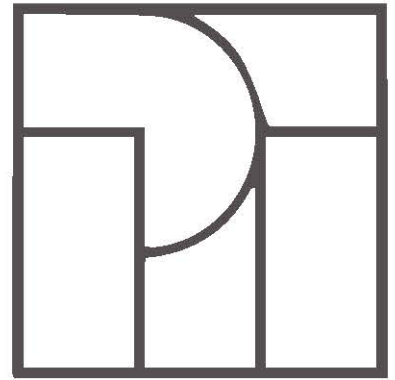

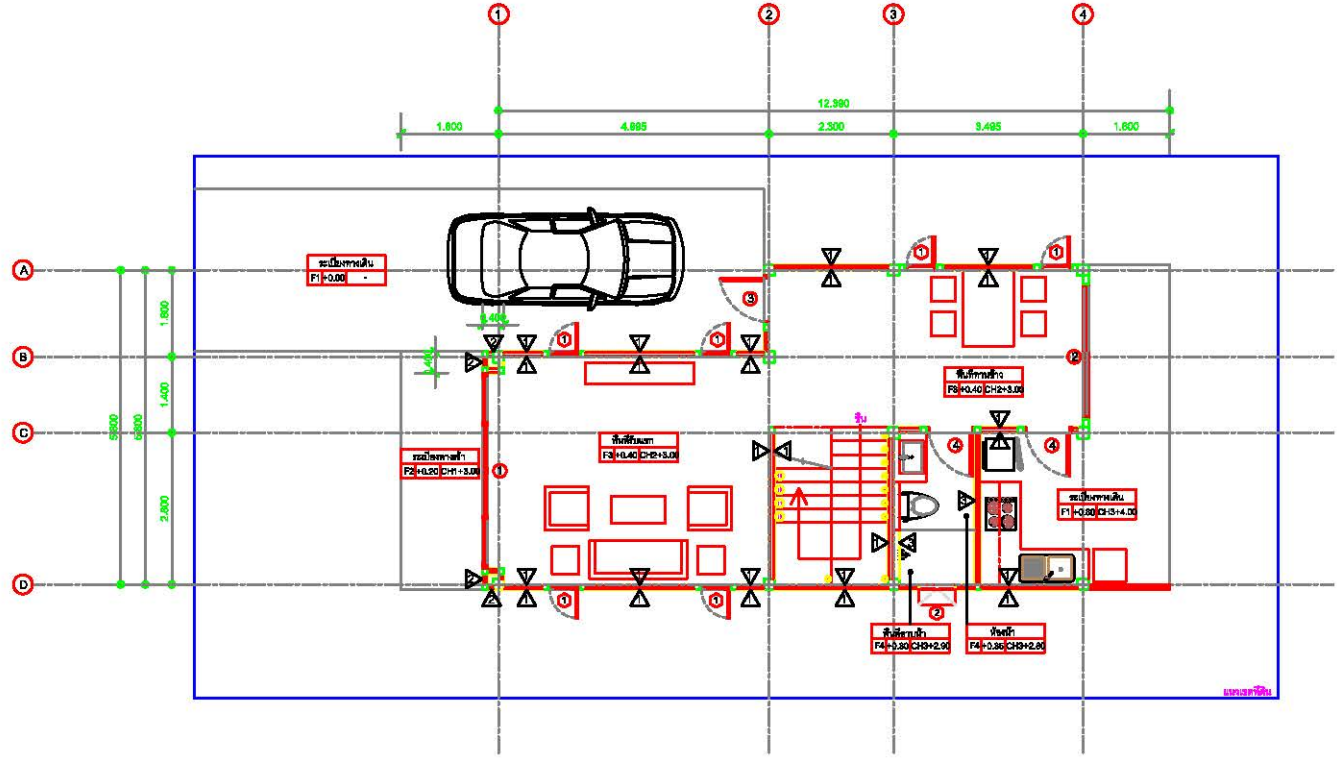

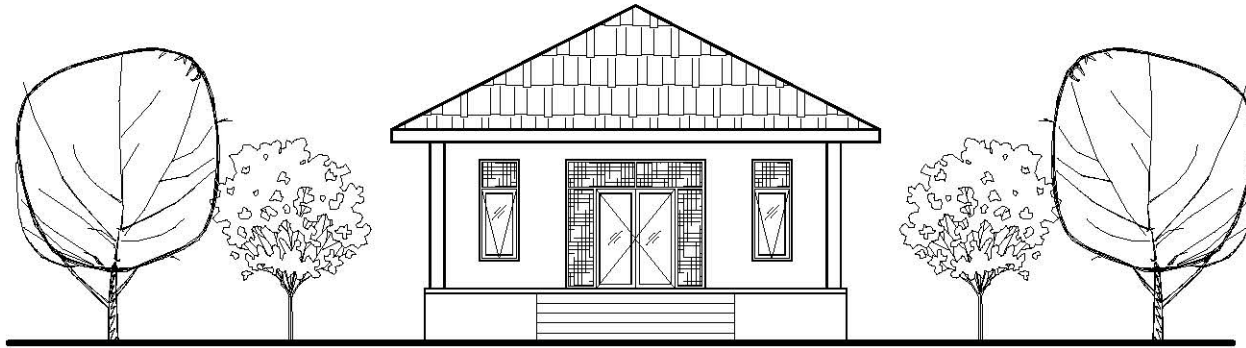
