
THE PAVILION OF 'SHIFT'




















THE TWIST OF THE GALAXY

This project is an experimental and theoretical project When you are living in the galaxy, you need different ways of exploring spaces. In order to create interesting and unimaginable spaces, digital means are the best way to explore possibilities of space in architecture. The experiment of this task starts with a few basic primitives that will aggregate during the process. For example, a chef will put different ingredients into a pot and each ingredient would produce different outcome. Whereas in this project, software like rhinoceros and grasshopper is the pot and the ingredient including primitives and verbs.

Note: This is an early exploration which does not have a conclusive and resolved architecture. The same methods are applied in the later works in the portfolio which produce resolved architecture.








ENTROPY

Low - Medium - High When entropy is high , often interpreted as the degree of disorder or randomness in the system.




SECOND LAW OF THERMODYNAMICS

In thermodynamics, a parameter representing the state of disorder of a system at the atomic, ionic, or molecular level; the greater the disorder the higher the entropy.




- State 1 -Outside In







- State 3 -Right to Left



EXPERIMENT


















The Spirit of The Amber "THE KABIN"

Our fascination with the latvian mythology and its symbols has carved a deep impression an inspiration to showcase the elements of latvia's heritate. The juxtaposition of 3 significant latvian symbol forms the main components in this concept and translates itself into, 'The Kabin'.

This concept intends to adapt for different terrains by using 2 pairs of timber rafters forming the main structural framework for The Kabin. At the same time, the formation of these rafters signifies the latvian symbol of god represented by the series of triangles above the horizontal baseline (earth-mother).

This 45 sq/m cabin is elevated for easy visibility and provides some deterrent from the wild animals. The floor layout is simple with dedicated spaces for sleeping, dining and casual activities. Alternating steps to the loft above extends to function as a lounge bench with slopping back rest

The loft space is another dedicated sleeping area. Hammock spaces are designed to provide some therapeutic sleeping experience and social interaction below. This level can access to the outdoor deck for views from the rear of The Kabin. Outdoor benches provide a rest area for trekkers. These benches are arranged in the formation symbolising the Sign of the Star, signifying the protection from evil.
