Which, if you look carefully, the building mass is divided into two parts: there will be a carport and part of the residence, which the designer has tried to give homeowners or visitors. I walked in the wind that blew and saw the atmosphere of the Mekong River before entering the main house. It also leaves the area in front of the house as a garden area for residents to live in during the day. and outside in the evening.












KCA House Khonkaen

Homeowners want a modern-toppical style home. which this house can live with both owners Which is himself with a young wife, including father and mother, and the owner of the house wants a house that has functions, including being able to hold all people. because the construction area is narrow but deep and the sun passes through the front of the project.









The architect therefore designed the front as a large cube. and to open the interior area so that it can be used throughout the day, and the main bedroom area on the second floor.

It has the advantage that the wind can come through all year. Including being on the side that can see the view from the swamp as well. But there will be a problem where the sun will pass all day. The architect therefore designed it using wooden battens to filter the sun and keep the front elevation as well.












Khun Fah'House Ubon Ratchathani




Baan Khun Fah is located in Tambon Kham Yai.District of Ubon Ratchathani The home's approximate 170 square meters are divided among 3 bedrooms, 4 bathrooms, a living room, a kitchen, an office, and a storage room. The architecture of this home is contemporary. There is an Lshaped building layout, but if you look closely, you will realize that the house is separated into two parts, with a stair hall serving as a connection between both parts to share privacy and capture the passing breeze, which assists in cooling. It not only helps keep the house cool but also saves electricity during the day.

The issue in question came up because of the school's commitment that "every student who comes to school must be happy" and safe. and as near to nature as you're able to get.









SOLID SQUARE A simple solid square function
