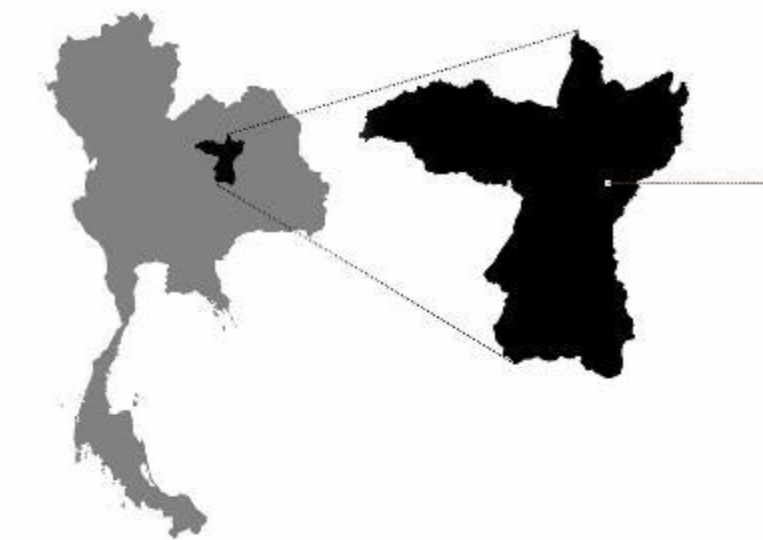

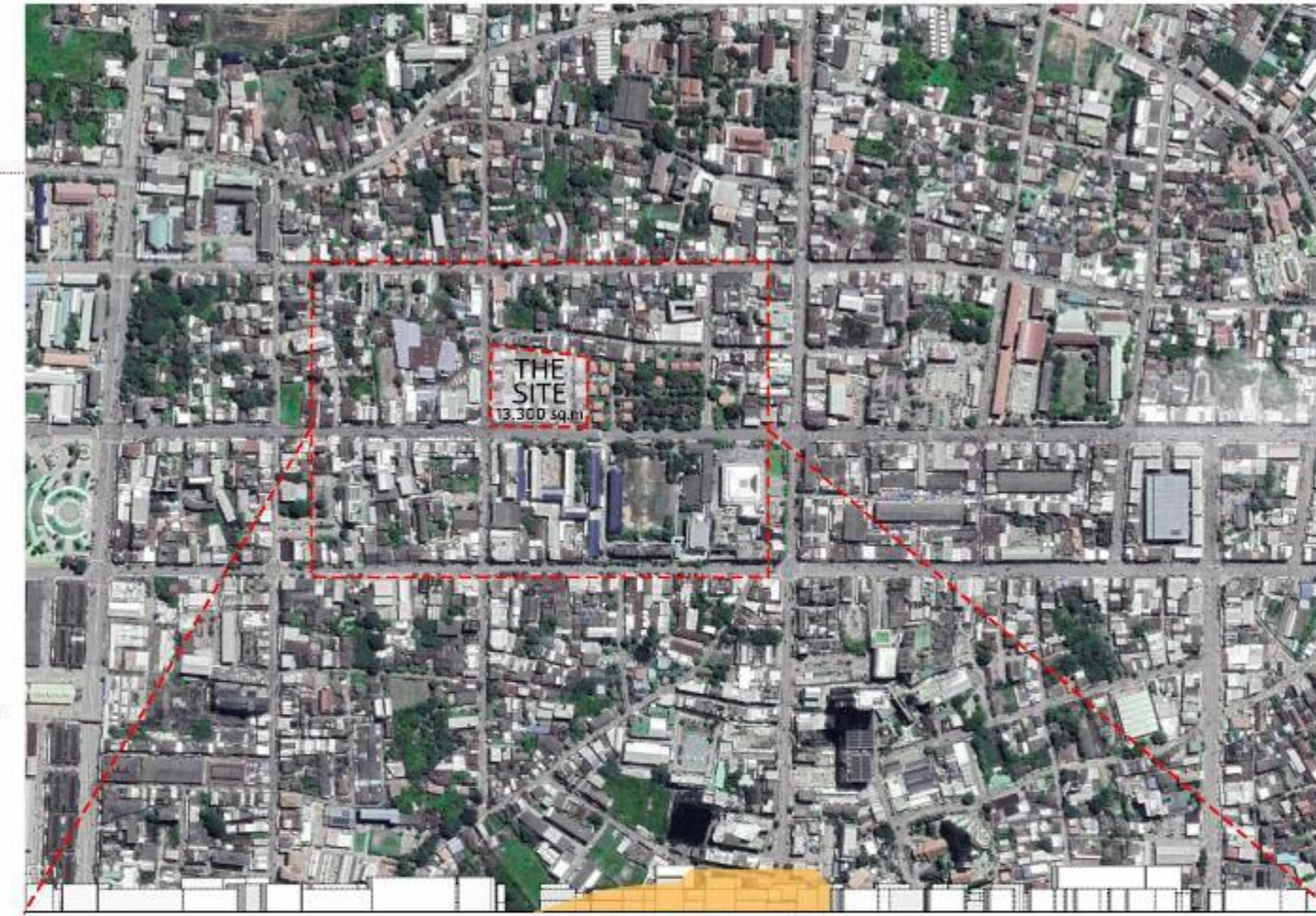
The construction site is in the centre of Khon Kaen, on the portion of the transit station that is vacant as a result of the city's growth

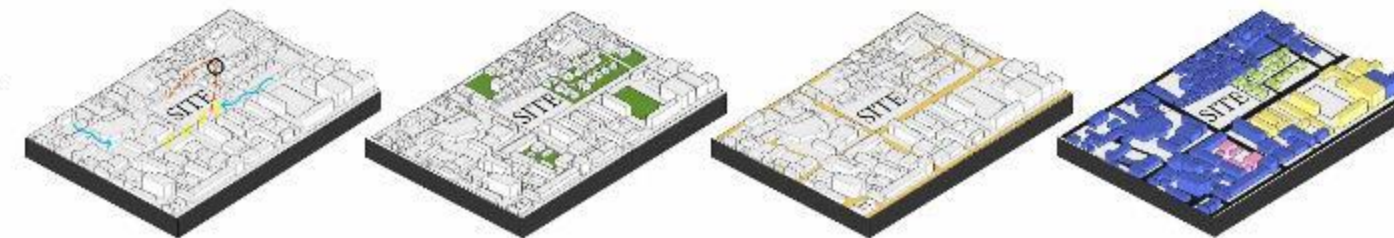
People typically visit Khon Kaen University's Central Library during test season if they need to do any work, however there are already too many people using it. The result is congestion.

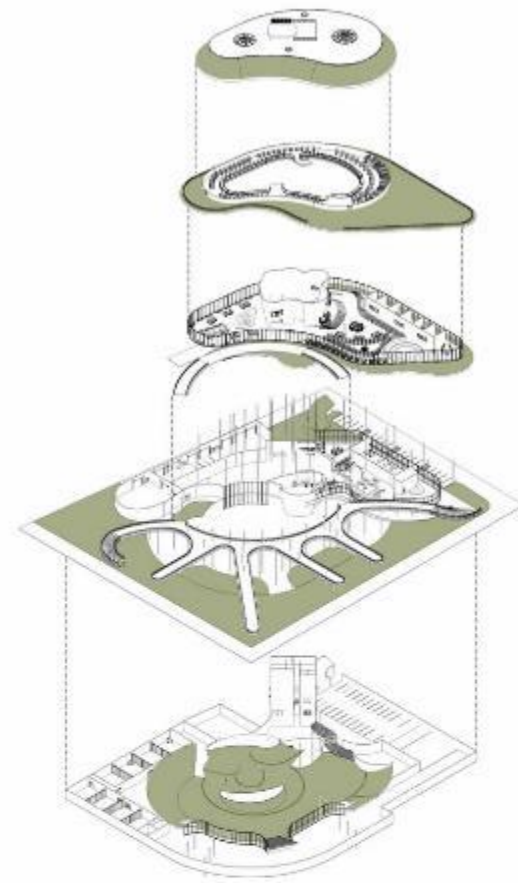
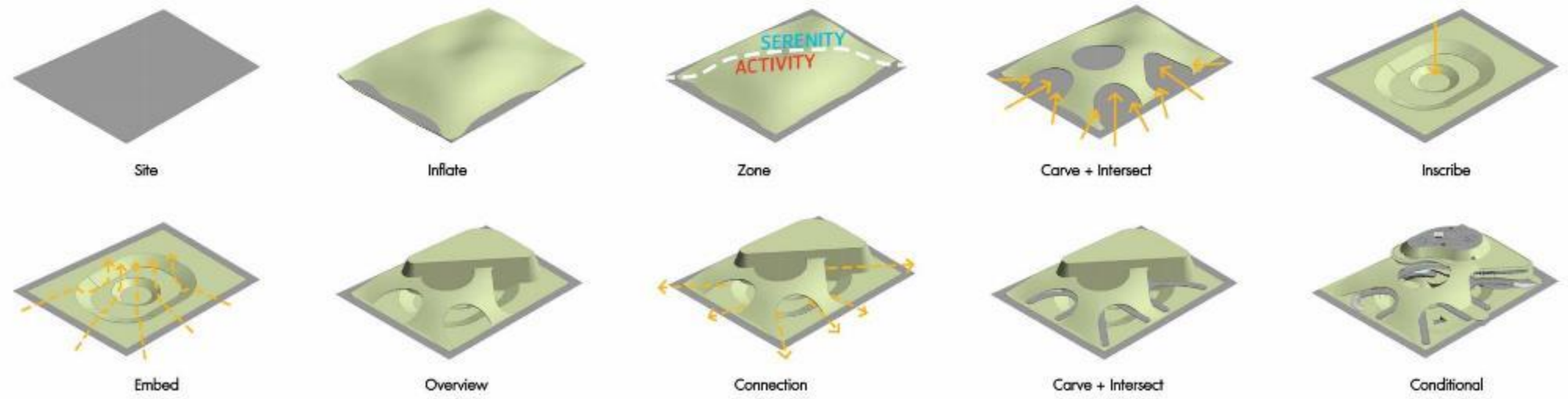
When people have a good environment able to access learning conveniently. The more public spaces and activities, it can make a difference.

Location: Ayutthaya, Thailand



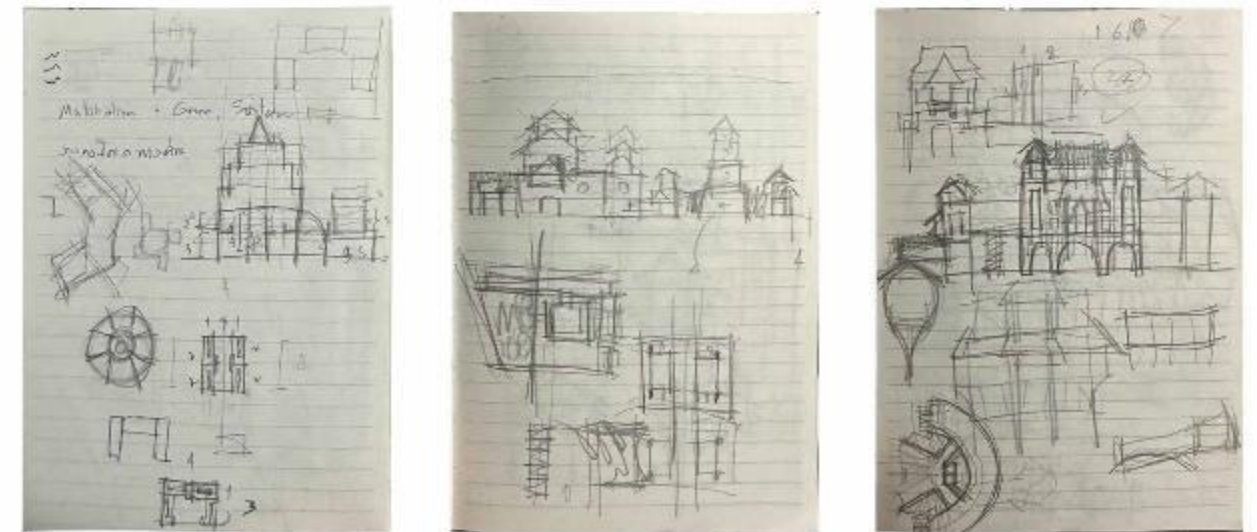
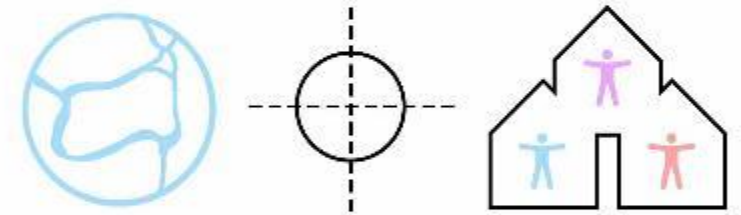

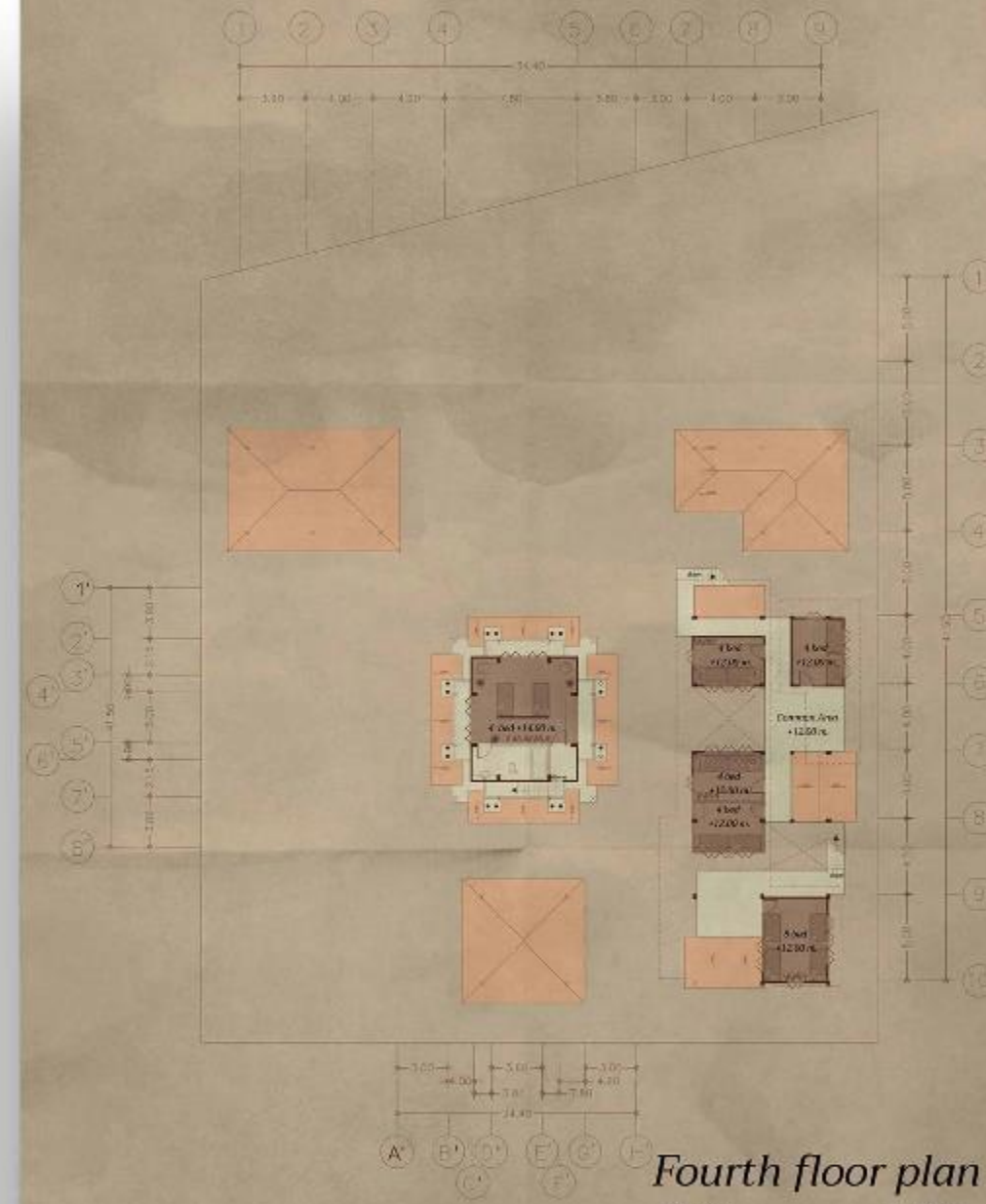
First floor plan

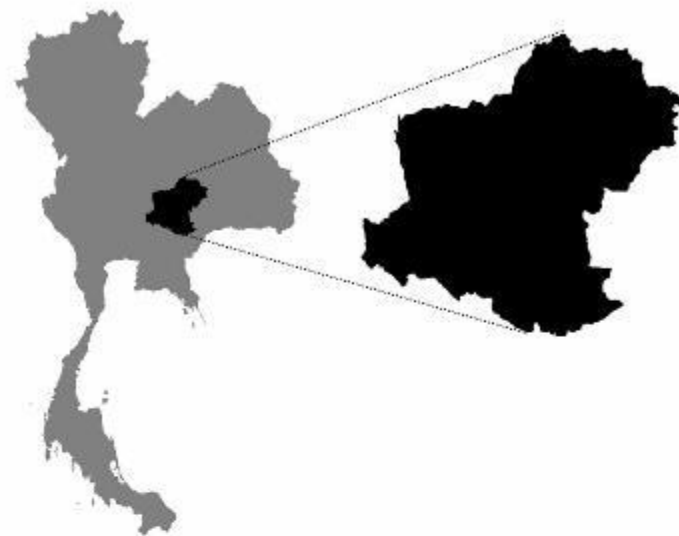

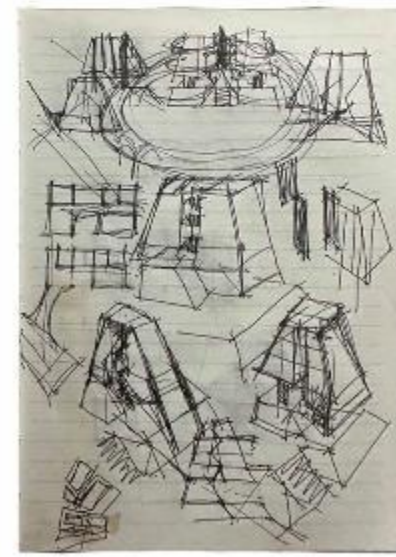
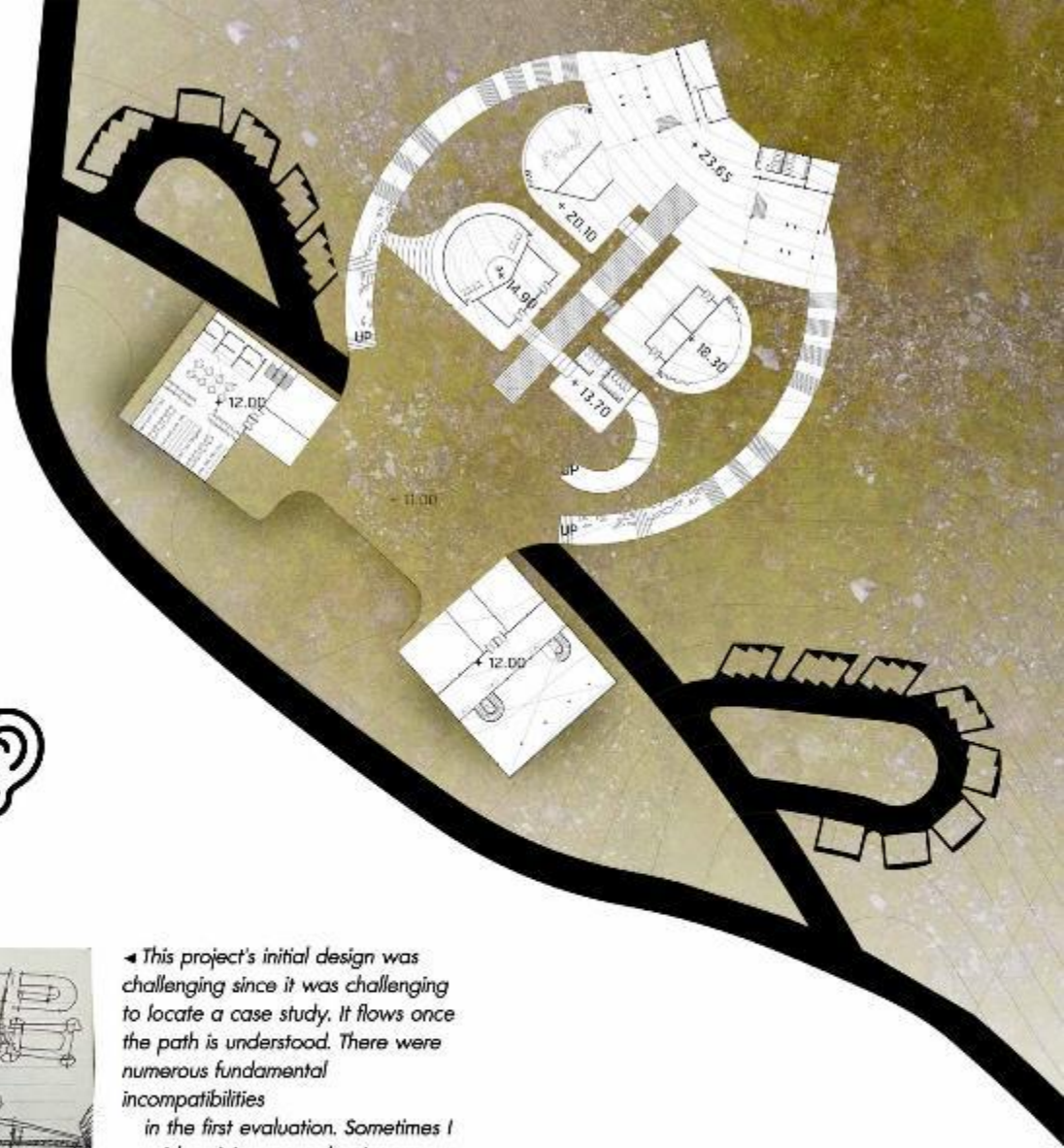

This area originally had a relatively small slope, making it suitable for display slopes and for children's activities.

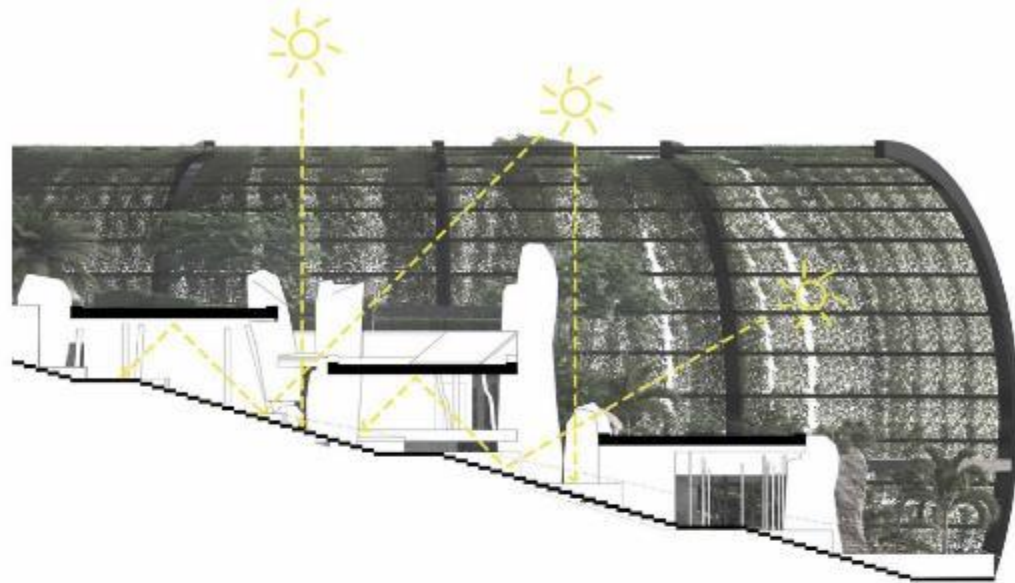
This area will be the connecting point from the front reception building to the main area of the project.



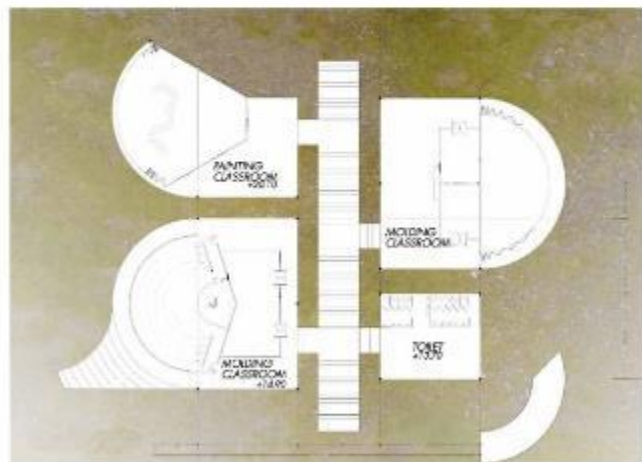
STRONG

The lower part of the body is designed as the pickup point of the restaurant, as well as various systems supporting the body, including the body and spirit.

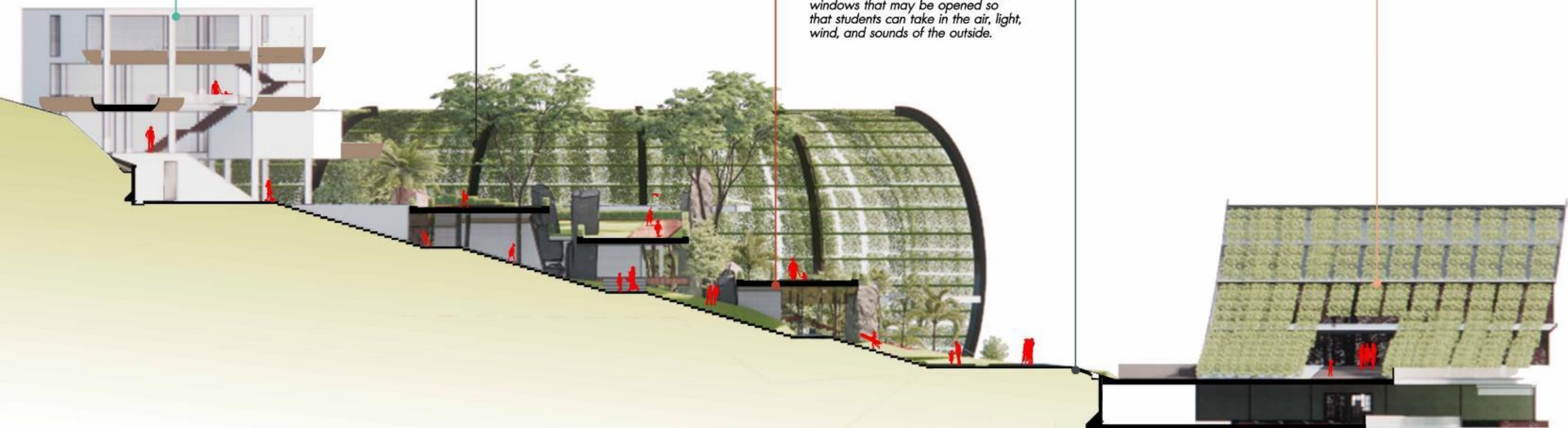
This part uses the lap part to be designed with the left side being the system work and the canteen. On the right is a cafe for those who are visiting.
