

# Residential Villa

Devra Architects

Project type: Residential Location : Chandigarh Site Area : 210 sq.m Year : 2020 Through the entrance, a hanging white box- study room welcomes the visitor, designed in a contemporary architectural style. The massiveness of the design is reduced by using full-height transparent glass. In addition, the laser-cut metal screens fixed on the glass help to filter the harsh southern sun rays. The cantilevered roof is cladded with a wooden finish high pressurized laminate (HPL) that enhances its aesthetical value.





The arrangement of functional spaces with minimum circulation passages helped to fulfill the client's brief in such a small footprint. The essence of the master bedroom's elegance lies in its right choice of materials and color palette. The highlighter tile- Granos Tobacco from Simpolo collection blends with the overall design language of the washroom.

Parametric chandelier, backlit bulkhead cladded with alabaster sheets, an array of inclined false ceiling strips are some of the key features of the design.














PLAN OF UPPER FRAME











# Weekend residence

# Commercial Plaza



The glazed skin of the commercial plaza is draped with an automated metal screen. The screen slides along its Y-axis as per the sun orientation to minimize heat gain. The double heightened travertine cladded coffered entrance frame and tapering columns act as a welcoming feature for the visitors.


The context of the site plays a vital role in the design process. The design is inspired by Fabric threads.


Features such as integrated services with structural members, activities under a single roof and Skylights, Louvers for natural light and ventilation makes it a more efficient design than a conventional railway station model.














# Lockdown Challenge Console Design- Dynosole





AXONOMETRIC EXPLODED VIEW




# Tube Conceptual Design Competition An Ephemeral Experiential Gallery
