

















Floor Plan













Reassembling the Library







Colour scheme of the materials found at Bo'ness Library











- Stone blockwork are mostly used.
- Uneven colour on the same surface. It is because colours of material has been changing through time due to the weather and pollution (i.e. sandstone absorbs carbon dioxide; some part turns grey)
- Water causing moss on stone (green)

Timber cladding

I want to use quite a lot of glass to let the natural light in, but I don't want it to be only glass too expose of the inside; because it feels too bare. Therefore, the use of timber structure in pattern helps obscure sight. Especially, on the wall facing the private residence. To stop people in the library looking into the private residence. However, it still allows sunlight to come into the space.


Reused of demolished stones








Tectonic Model on Site


