

Design Interventions





Zones are divided into 4 parts, where the Academic zone operates as a core and is placed within the walking distance from each zone. Public and institutional zones are placed first for easy reach of public and monitoring. The residential zones are placed at the back for privacy and to provide view of the valley.

Site has two road entries. The northward main road that provides access to Administration, Library, workshop and hostel is for more regular use. The secondary road at the bottom is for events and less frequent use. It provides access to sports utilities, Auditorium, OAT and faculty housing.





Functions of individual zones are sub-divided and intermediant spaces Area covered by building pad is shown in the figure by black color. like libaray, mess and sports are added. Residential zone is divided into The image represents the ratio of land coverga by buildings vs the student and faculty housing both connected through a road, shaded corridor and cycle track.



Connection between spaces

Academic block is designed in such a way that every classroom has it's own personal space which opens up into department's courtyard. That courtyard further opens up into a common central garden through which students will be able to see the activities happening in college. OAT is also placed in it for college gatherings, events and breaks.



Dance Studio overlooking to valley

All classrooms opens up to views of mountains and valley. A mini auditorium is shared by dance and music deaprtments which has two small rotating conference halls for lectures. The rotating hall acts as an individual space, and also merge into big auditorium to increase capacity.



Green Corridor

All the deaprtments are linked together by a double highted green corridor which act as cooling machine. As the hot wind enters the site from south-west, it first gets cooled down by water reservoir then further by the plants in corridor which also absorbs the water content from air. The plantation on the roof of corridor and the louvers at outer edge protect passage from sun.




Bridge connecting departments

To maintain the accessibility, lift is provided to access the first floor and floors of all the departments are linked through a common bridge. Cycle routes are loacted near to deaprtments for easier access.









Hostels are designed as an Co-ed hostels to bring more freedom in collaborations and working together as creatives. All rooms have views of either valley or common garden from their room. As the two building blocks are on a 5m contour interval difference, they are connected through ramps and stairs. A bridge is also given for upper floors which passes through common hall, the first floor of mess. The OAT at center invites students for events, jamming and sports. Both blocks have terrace and green roof with solar panels to reduce running cost.


Visitor's Hostel







MICRO CLIMATE IN EXTREME SUMMER






Ground Floor Beam layout


