


## WAT PATHUM WANARAM MOCK UP

WE HAVE BEEN TRY USING MANY COLOURS, SET ANGLE, AND CHANG POSITION OF THE LIGHT SOURCES TO FIND THE PERFECT COMBINATION THAT REPRSENT OUR CONCEPT. FROM EXPERIMENT, WE DECIDED TO USE PURPLE AND YELLOW TO REPRESENT THE PEACE AND RESPECT. WE SET THE ANGLE OF THE LUMINAIRE PARALLEL TO THE WALL TO AVOIDED THE EXCESS LIGHT ON THE WALL AS SAMEAS THE POSITION OF THE LIGHT SOURCES. THE TWO COLOURS WE USED COME FROM THAI BELIEVE. SINCE IN THAI, CANDLE SYMBOLIZED WORSHIP AND PURPLE MEANS CONCENTRATION.








Plan F1 3D Section Isometric








The Buddha Image Shrine Plan




