NITHI STHAPITANONDA

Founder

National Artist of Thailand In Architecture

Our founder, Nithi Sthapitanonda, an alumnus of Chulalongkorn University and University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, founded Architects 49 in 1983. During his years at A49, he has held the position of President of the Association of Siamese Architects under Royal Patronage between 1992-1994 and the Secretary General for the Architect Council of Thailand from 2000-2002. In 2002, he received the honor of being named by the Ministry of Culture as a "National Artist" in Contemporary Architecture.

Nithi was appointed Honorary Member of the Japan Institute of Architects (JIA) in 1995 and Honorary Fellow of the American Institute of Architects (AIA) in the USA in 2008. In 2013, he received an Honorary Doctorate in Science in the field of Architecture from Sripatum University. Additionally, he has served on a number of boards and acted as a trustee for various organizations. Nithi has also chaired several judging committees for numerous prestigious awards, ranging from the Thai Ministry of Culture to Silpakorn University. A prolific master of drawing, Nithi has, over the past 40 years, collated a vast collection of his own ink drawings from his early school years onwards. He has developed a style and technique in pen and ink drawing that is well recognized among Thai architects and students. Approaching his retirement from A49, Nithi started Li-Zenn Publishing Limited, the publishing company of his dreams, and began to work on the design of religious buildings. Over the last ten years he has designed a number of wats (temples) and stupas, a few of which have received awards from the ASA. In undertaking such works, he has re-established a public interest in Thai religious architecture, long absent from local scene.



PRABHAKORN VADANYAKUL

Executive Advisor

Prabhakorn attained his Bachelor of Architecture degree from Chulalongkorn University in 1980. Following further studies at the Catholic University of America in Washington, DC, he graduated with a Master of Architecture degree in 1984. Prabhakorn then worked at Robert Schwinn & Associates in Maryland before returning to Thailand to join A49 in 1985. He has since been responsible for a wide range of projects from mega complexes and high-rise buildings, to private residences located in Thailand and the South East Asia region, namely China, Malaysia, Singapore and Vietnam. His work has also extended to the United Arab Emirates and India, adding breadth to A49's portfolio of work. Prabhakorn has been central in establishing major policies, design concepts and strategic planning initiatives for A49. He was appointed President of Architects 49 (Phuket) in 2005 and President of Architects 49 International in 2006.

Prabhakorn actively served as Head of Public Relations for the Association of Siamese Architects (ASA) from 1992 to 1994, its Vice President of Foreign Affairs from 1995 to 1997 as well as its President from 2002 to 2004. He has also contributed his experience to many subcommittees of both the ASA and the Architect Council of Thailand (ACT), and is an active Council Member of the ACT. Prabhakorn was also named an Honorary Member of the Japan Institute of Architects (JIA) in 2003.

Prabhakorn has been a key member of A49 since its foundation and entrusted by Nithi Sthapitanonda, the founder of Architects 49, to serve as the current President and Managing Director of 49Group.



SUWAT VASAPINYOKUL

President

Suwat Vasapinyokul graduated from Chulalongkorn University with a Bachelor of Architecture degree in 1983 and joined A49 as a founding member of staff. He has since been responsible for a large portfolio of architectural works, which includes a variety of building types, from private residences and apartment buildings to large office buildings and shopping complexes. Suwat pursued his postgraduate studies, outside of work, at Chulalongkorn University and attained a Master of Business Administration degree in 1992. He was promoted to a Director of A49 in 1990, and Vice President in 1992.

Suwat's expertise in business development and management led him to be appointed Managing Director of IA49, the interior design firm and an affiliated company to A49. After the re-structuring of A49 in 2001, Suwat became Chair of the Board of Directors, and has since been responsible for A49 business development and management policy.



RATTAWUT CHANSRITRAKUL

Managing Director

Rattawut Chansritrakul received a Bachelor of Architecture with honours from Chulalongkorn University in 1993. He began his professional career as an architect at Architects 49. After four years, he went on to pursue his graduate studies, focusing on the integration between architectural design and building technology. Rattawut attained a Masters of Science in Architecture from the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, USA, in 1999. Upon graduating, Rattawut returned to Thailand and took on the position of a full-time lecturer at Chulalongkorn University's Faculty of Architecture, where he remained for four years. In 2004, he returned to Architects 49, becoming a Partner in 2007 and was concurrently appointed Executive Director of Architects 49 (Chiangmai). Rattawut is currently serving as the Deputy Managing Director of Architects 49 House Design, where the philosophy of "Innovative and Integrated Design Specialist" is addressed with sophistication.

While working as an architect, Rattawut had keen interest in the research of "Architectonic in Tropical Architecture", and contributed as a part-time lecturer in "Detail Design" course work at the Faculty of Architecture, Chulalongkorn University. Furthermore, Rattawut is frequently invited to be a guest editor for architectural journals organised by Li-Zenn Publishing. His editorial contributions include Architects 49's Architectural Detail Series Volume 1: Stair, Volume 4: Facade / Canopy and the Monograph Profile such as H-Definition, Architects 49 House Design.

Furthermore, under the name of Architects 49 House Design, Rattawut has received recognition through national and international awards. Consequently, he is regularly invited as guest speaker for special events, and to judge or be part of the jury for architectural design competitions. His much lauded and award-winning works have been featured in various publications and on social media.

Karnchit Punyakanok received a Bachelor of Architecture degree with first class honors from Chulalongkorn University in 1990. He continued his education at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, attaining a Master of Architecture and a Master of Sciences in Civil Engineering (Construction Management) in 1993. Upon graduation, Karnchit joined Architects 49 as a designer, working on projects of various scales and types including private residences, Panyavej Hospital, the Mercy Centre hospice, and Central World shopping complex. He was promoted to Associate in 2000 and became a Partner of the firm in 2006.

Karnchit has served the Association of Siamese Architects in various roles, including its subcommittee for the Architect Exposition, in 1995, 1996, 2001, 2002, and 2006.

Viyada also won an award in a design competition for the emblem marking the 50th anniversary celebrations of H.M. King Bhumibol's accession to the throne.

Korrakoth is a Senior Architect and currently serves as the Executive Director of Architects 49 (Chiangmai).




KITTITHAT NILSUWAN Executive Director
